Plastic packaging must now be collected in transparent plastic bags.

#### How to get the transparent plastic bags for your household?

- Order via our app «MIN RENOVASJON» (English optional in settings)
- Order via our Facebook page HAF - Helgeland Avfallsforedling IKS
- Send an Email to haf@haf.no
- Visit our customer centre in Nordre Gate 21, Rana
- Call our customer service centre - 751 98 200
- Tie a bag on your residual-waste container to signal the need of a new bag

#### Where to place the transparent bags?

The transparent bag must be placed visibly by the residual-waste containers. Wind and weather vary, so make sure to attach the bags to the waste containers.

#### When will the transparent bags be collected?

The pickup- dates could be found in our helpful app «MIN RENOVASJON». The frequency for plastic-waste pickup is usually once a month. The app provides you with these dates as well as tips for your everyday waste management.

## Where to find the recycling stations?

The recycling stations can be found locally around our region. Paper/ cardboard, fabrics, glass and metal are usual items that can be delivered to these stations.

Tip! These local recycling stations have lower capacity and fewer types of waste than our larger recycling facilities. We recommend checking the app for more information about your recycling station.
